'Ammaar In Makkah

The mother returned the greeting by saying, "Wa ʻalaikum us-salaamu wa rahmatul-laahi wa barakaatuh," which means, "May peace and Allāh's mercy and blessings be on you too." She asked them how they were and 'Ammaar answered, "We are well, all praise be to Allah. Father promised to take us to Makkah for 'Umrah during the holiday in the middle of the school year. The holiday starts today." His mother answered, "Yes, I will help you prepare for the journey." 'Ammaar said, "All praise be to Allāh, I finished memorizing the fifteenth part of

the Qur'ān." He started preparing his suitease and he remembered to bring the two garments for *Ihraam*. 'Ammaar's mother is very happy with her sons 'Ammaar and 'Abdur-Rahmaan and she prays to Allāh to make them among the believers who memorize His Book and do what it says.

'Ammaar's mother said many other prayers to Allāh for her children. A few minutes later, they heard someone knocking on the door. They answered the door happily because they knew it was time for their father to come back from work. They heard his voice from behind the door greeting their neighbor Shaikh Ibraahim.

When 'Ammaar opened the door, his father came in and gave greetings of peace to everyone. The family returned the father's greetings of peace, and 'Ammaar and 'Abdur-Rahmaan went to their room. It is their habit that when their father comes back from work, they

do not talk to him about anything until he changes his clothes and rests.

O young boy! Mention Allāh's Name, eat with your right hand and eat from the part of food that is in front

of you."

Before they finished eating, 'Ammaar said to his father, "We are all ready to go to Makkah except for my mom who is going to look after Faatimah, my youngest sister. Mom helped me prepare my suitcase and what we need for the journey." He hopes that the trip for 'Umrah will not be delayed. His father said, "Yes, my son. In shaa' Allaah (if Allāh wills), after 'Asr today or Fair tomorrow, we will go to Makkah by ear." Baasim, 'Ammaar's youngest brother, said, "I, too, want to go with you, father." The father said, "Yes, we are all going for 'Umrah. Let me remind you of what the Messenger of Allah said about the benefits of 'Umrah. He said:

«الْعُمْرَةُ إِلَى الْعُمْرَةِ كَفَّارَةٌ لِمَا بَيْنَهُمَا مِنَ النُّمُورِ لَيْسَ لَهُ النَّنُوبِ وَالْخَطَايَا. وَالْحَجُّ الْمَبْرُورُ لَيْسَ لَهُ جَزَاءٌ إِلَّا الْجَنَّةُ»
