

CHAPTER No: 1

At-Tauhid (The Oneness of Allâh)

Allâh the Almighty said:

"And I (Allâh) created not the *Jinns* and men except they should worship Me (Alone)." (51:56)

And He stated:

"And verily, We have sent among every *Ummah* (community, nation) a Messenger (proclaiming): 'Worship Allâh (Alone), and avoid (or keep away from) *Tâghut* (all false deities etc. i.e. do not worship *Tâghut* besides Allâh).' "(16:36)

And He said:

"And your Lord has decreed that you worship none but Him. And that you be dutiful to your parents. If one of them or both of them attain old age in your life, say not to them a word of disrespect, nor shout at them but address them in terms of honour. And lower unto them the wing of submission and humility through mercy, and say: 'My Lord! Bestow on them Your Mercy as they did bring me up when I was small.' "(17:23,24)

And He said:

﴿ وَأَعْبُدُوا ٱللَّهَ وَلَا تُشْرِكُوا بِهِ عَسُنَّكًا ﴾

"Worship Allâh and join none with Him in worship." (4:36) And He said:

﴿ قُلُ تَعَالَوْاأَتُلُ مَا حَرَّمَ رَبُّكُمْ عَلَيْكُمْ أَلَا تُشْرِكُواْ بِهِ شَيْئًا وَبِالْمَمْ وَبِالْمَوْ الْمَدَوْ الْمَدُوا الْفَوْرَ وَلَا تَقْدُوا النَّفُسُ الَّذِي حَرَّمَ اللَّهُ اللَّهُ وَصَدَكُم بِهِ لِعَلَّكُمْ نَعْقِلُونَ ٥ وَلَا نَقْرَبُوا مَالَ الْيَتِيمِ إِلَّا بِاللَّذِي هِي اللَّهُ الللْمُ اللَّهُ اللَّهُ

"Say (O Muhammad صلى الله عليه وسلم): Come, I will recite what your Lord has prohibited you from: Join not anything in worship with Him; be good and dutiful to your parents; kill your children because of poverty - We provide sustemance for you and for them; come not near to shameful (illegal sexual intercourse, etc.) whether committed openly or secretly, and kill not anyone whom Allah has forbidden, except for a just cause (according to Islamic law). This He has commanded you that you may understand. And come not near to the orphan's property, except to improve it, until he (or she) attains the age of full strength; and give full measure and full weight with justice. We burden not any person, but that which he can bear. And whenever you give vour word (i.e. judge between men or give evidence, etc.), say the truth even if a near relative is concerned and fulfill the Covenant of Allâh. This He commands you, that you may remember. And verily, this is My Straight Path, so follow it, and follow not (other) paths, for they will separate you away

from His Path. This He has ordained for you that you may become *Al-Muttaqûn* (the pious)." (6:151-153)

Ibn Mas'ud رضى الله عنه said:

«مَنْ أَرَادَ أَنْ يَنْظُرَ إلى وَصِيَّةِ مُحَمَّدٍ عَلَيْهِ التِي عَلَيْها خَاتَمَه فَلْيَقرَأ قولهُ تعالى: ﴿ قُلْ تَعَالَوَا أَتَلُ مَا حَرَّمَ رَبُّكُمُ عَلَيْكُمُ مَّلَكُمُ أَلًا تُشْرِكُوا بِهِ عَلَيْكُمُ مَا تَقيمًا ﴾. تُشْرِكُوا بِهِ عَسَيْقًا الله قوله - وَأَنَّ هَذَا صِرَطِي مُسْتَقِيمًا ﴾.

Whoever wishes to ascertain the very will of Prophet Muhammad ملى الله عليه وسلم on which the Prophet has put his seal, let him read the Statement of Allâh:

"Say (O Muhammad صلی الله علیه وسلم): Come, I will recite what your Lord has prohibited you from: Join not anything in worship with Him... (up to) ... And verily, this is My Straight Path."

It is narrated that Mu'âdh bin Jabal رضى الله عنه said:

I was riding behind the Prophet صلى الله عليه وسلم on a donkey and he said to me "O Mu'âdh, do you know what is the right of Allâh on his slaves and what is the right of the slaves upon Allâh?" I responded: "Allâh and His Messenger know best." He continued, "The Right of Allâh upon His slaves, is to worship Him Alone and never to associate anything with
